## CÔTE DE BEAUPRÉ by bus

Visit and discover the Côte-de-Beaupré and its main attractions. You will visit Montmorency Falls, considered as the highest fall of Quebec province; it is 98 feet taller than the Niagara Falls.

Then discover the Canyon Sainte-Anne, where you can enjoy the hiking trails and walk on the 3 suspended bridges, while enjoying the beautiful scenery including the majestic Sainte-Anne fall, the Île d'Orléans and the Basilica of Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré.

A short trip will take you at the Basilica of Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré, where you could visit the basilica and have free time to visit the museum. After your visit you will continue towards Île d'Orléans where you will enjoy the spectacular view of the Montmorency Falls and Quebec City.
